PREAMBLE

In the reference 1st cited, the Government in G.O.(Ms) No. 147, dated: 05.05.2023 of Health and Family Welfare (PME-2) Department, has permitted Karpaga Vinayaga Educational Trust, Pudukkottai, to start B.Pharm. Degree Course with an annual intake of 100 seats in the name and style of “**Karpaga Vinayaga Institute for Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chengalpattu**” in S.F. Nos. 114/2, 114/3, 115 in Vaiyavoor Panchayat, Moosivakam Village, Maduranthagam Taluk and Panchayat Union, Chengalpattu District, from the academic year 2023-2024.

2. In the reference 2nd cited, the University has granted the Provisional Affiliation order to Karpaga Vinayaga Institute for Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chengalpattu for conducting the B.Pharm. Degree Course with an annual intake of 60 seats from the Academic Year 2023-2024.

3. In the reference 3rd cited, Letter of Consent of Affiliation has been issued to increase of annual intake from 60 to 100 seats in B.Pharm. degree course, based on the request from the said institution and after conducting requisite inspection by the University.

4. In the reference 4th cited, the Principal, Karpaga Vinayaga Institute for Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chengalpattu has requested to grant permission for increase of intake from 60 to 100 seats along with the PCI approval.

5. In the reference 5th cited, the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi (PCI) has granted approval for 100 seats for the academic year 2024-2025 to conduct B.Pharmacy degree course at Karpaga Vinayaga Institute for Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chengalpattu.

6. Based on the request of the Institution and approval of the PCI, an inspection was conducted on 30.08.2024 by the Inspection Commission constituted for the grant of Permission for increase of intake from 60 to 100 seats for the academic year 2024-2025.

7. On scrutiny of the inspection report and the documents submitted, no specific adverse remarks or objection was found.

ORDER:

8. In the pursuance of the above, the University grants permission to “**Karpaga Vinayaga Institute for Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chengalpattu**” for increase of annual intake from 60 to 100 seats in B.Pharm. degree course for the academic year 2024-2025 as indicated below subject to the usual conditions already intimated in the Provisional Affiliation orders of this University.
